Request for Decision: Request by Public Mobile to install and operate a wireless communications site

Presence of Kevin Fleischer (Legal Services), David Lahache, Lois Williams. Agreement to allow Public Mobile to rent space on the K103 tower located at the Kahnawà:ke Sports Complex. Revenues of \$20,000 per year to be split between K103 and MCK, with 2.5% annual increase. Based on ten year lease, with a right to renew or negotiate extension. Passed unanimously.

Request for Decision: Draft Amendments to the 2008 Clean Soil Policy request for final approval, including approval for increase in Landfill Fees

Request for Decision, Mohawk Council Executive Directive: Transfer of Community Member from the Moricetown First Nation List under the Federal Registry to the Kahnawà:ke List

The community member was never removed from the Kahnawà:ke Kanien'kehá:ka Registry but, due to Federal requirements, MCK must inform Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada that the transfer back to Kahnawà:ke is accepted 'for the record.' Passed unanimously.
