## Agenda:

Categorization of Kahnawà:ke Tobacco Law: Presence of Ron Skye, Kahente Horn-Miller (KLCC) & Marylee Armstrong (Legal). Chief and Council voted 8 – 4 in favor of the recommended Type II Law categorization and mandated it as an Urgent law through the Community Decision Making Process. Chiefs voting for Type I were Gina Deer, Billy Diabo, Martin Leborgne and Carl Horn.

**Presentation of Landfill Report:** Presence of Alana Goodleaf-Rice, Kevin Kennedy, Paul Rice (EDO), Marylee Armstrong & Kevin Fleischer (Legal). The report recommends limited small scale operations for the 2014 season and a complete restructuring of the current operations to ensure that only acceptable landfill material is enters the community. The report and recommendations were unanimously accepted by all twelve (12) chiefs.

Council clarification for Capital to move excess soils associated with its works to another location in the Community: Clarification on this item occurred during the Landfill Report discussion.
