### **Chiefs Attendance**

### **Housekeeping:**

- An official announcement on the National Aboriginal Training Center will take place on Sunday, June 21 in Mashteuiatsh, Quebec.
- The Assembly of First Nations of Quebec and Labrador General Assembly will take place in Montreal next week from June 9-11.
- Chief Mike Bush updated the table on his recent visit to Oneida, Wisconsin, including an overview of their Justice System.

### **The following agenda items were discussed:**

#### **Land Allotments**

Various Land Allotments were officially designated

#### **Acceptance of Kanawaki Lease Funds (Marcy Delisle)**

It's expected that approximately \$27,000 in interest for the last two years will be received by the MCK on behalf of the Community for the portion of Kanawaki which is on common land. Other parts of the lease are on private land.

#### **Mohawk Self Insurance (MSI) Premiums**

Adjustments needed to be made to ensure the stability of the program. Businesses were sent notification by MSI that premiums would be adjusted and will be notified again of their adjustments as rates by industry vary. Changes to premiums will occur over the next 9 months.

#### **Seigneurie of Sault St. Louis (SSSL) Negotiation Funding**

A discussion took place on the funding for SSSL Negotiations and the proposed funding to be borrowed from the Department of Indian Affairs was approved.

#### **Removal of Clay Mountains**

A discussion took place on a proposal to remove the clay mountains close to the seaway in order to be able to use the Community owned land adjacent to the seaway. There would be no cost to Kahnawà:ke. No official decisions were made.

The meeting adjourned at noon.
