- A Support letter for the Kateri Hospital expansion project agreement, presented by Chief Rhonda Kirby, was accepted with minor modifications.
- A Vegetation Management Program from Canadian Pacific Rail wishes to spray herbicides along the train track that runs through the territory in order to control vegetation that may cause potential safety problems. More follow up will be conducted. This will be added to the agenda for Tuesday, September 2.
- Chief Rhonda Kirby has requested to visit the Seneca Nation to observe the operations of a Tobacco stamping facility (next week).
