Portfolio Updates for the Month:

November 2024

A main event in this month was the virtual meeting that took place between myself and Quebec's Premier Francois Legault.

 Overall It was a positive meeting that focused on the return of the outstanding 211 acre debt from Quebec. There is a very interesting prospect not to far away from Kahnawa:ke. There is a bit more work that needs to be done before it is unveiled to the Community. Some environmental studies are needed to see if it is even viable.

The file regarding the Northvolt Litigation entered into an interesting phase. Quebec wants the litigation to be stopped and approached Kahnawa:ke on this possibility. The Council had met and stated the only way we would considered a pause to the litigation would be if Northvolt agreed to halt development for a short period of time so Kahnawa:ke could meet with Quebec. I am glad to report that Northvolt did agree to this and will be stopping work on Dec 17th for 45 days. Council will meet to find parameters to discuss.

Myself and Ratsenhaienhs Ryan Montour met with Shadow Minister of CIRNAC and ISC Jamie Schmale.

- The goal was to begin establishing a positive relationship with Conservatives. This meeting came from an invitation I sent to Pierre Poilievre the Conservative Leader. On a similar note there is a future meeting that is going to be held with Poilievre in the next few weeks and it was stated he will come to Kahnawa:ke to meet.
- The meeting with Schmale was positive and while in Ottawa for the AFN Schmale agreed to meet again and bring other members of his party to meet with the myself and others from Council attending AFN.

More strategy sessions are being held between the EGR Team and the SSSL Team. In the coming weeks we will be launching a big educational campaign as well as other actions.

Myself and Ratsenhaienhs Iohahiio Delisle met with Chateauguay Mayor to re-establish communication channels to work towards improving the relation.

Portfolio Updates for the Month:

November 2024

Justice Portfolio:

-Attended the Canadian Institute for the Administration of Justice – Indigenous Justice System – A Knowledge Sharing Symposium held in the Tsuut'ina Nation, Calgary. The focus of the discussions was on Indigenous justice initiatives, the design and implementation of Indigenous legal institutions in different communities, the challenges and successes encountered by each community and the need for system reform. Shared our design and implementation of the Justice Act and the important role of Skén:nen Aonsón:ton in our justice system. Participated in two informational site visits – one to the Tsuut'ina Peacemaker Court and the other to the Calgary Indigenous Court.

-Work is ongoing on the full implementation of the Kahnawà:ke Justice Act. Council was presented with the two draft regulations respecting eligibility criteria and selection and appointment of judges. The drafts were posted online for a 30 day feedback period on November 18, 2024. Candidates for the Administrative Tribunal decision-maker positions were evaluated and a formal recommendation on appointments will be brought to Council December 10th.

Governance: Discussed communication plan for the community review and approval of 4 governance documents (Code of Conduct, 2X Terms of Reference and Administration Guidelines). Plan to include a KTV segment, K103 segment, an educational/informational component, including posting of the documents, workshops/kiosks and possibly focus groups. Review of commentary provided in each document.

Cannabis file: Met to discuss retail framework, payment processing, annual costs for the cannabis control office and control board and socio-economic development fund committee.

Legislation: Ongoing work on the draft Constitution of the KLC and the mandate of the legislative services.
