

National Claims Processed: Federal Indian Day Schools and Federal Day Schools

Over 200,000 First Nations and Inuit children across Canada were forced to attend these schools during the day and went home at night. From 1920 to 1988, 699 Indian Day schools across Canada - 65 in Quebec and 10 in Kahnawake, Kahnawake has the second largest number besides Six Nations.

Day schools were excluded from the residential school settlement. Garry McLean and his lawyers, Gowling WLG, reached an out-of-court settlement with the federal government in the late 2018.
