First Hearing tonight for proposed amendments to Election Law

(Kahnawake – 23, Tsothohrhkó:wa/January 2018) The Kahnawà:ke Legislative Coordinating Commission (KLCC) would like to remind community members that the First Hearing for proposed amendments to the *Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke Election Law* will take place **this evening** from 6 pm to 8:30 pm at the Golden Age Club.

The subject matters to be discussed tonight include:

- Development of Preamble and Purpose statements;
- Setting a definite date for the election;
- Appointment of the Electoral Officer by the Kahnawà:ke Justice Commission;
- Clarification of and, if need be, removal of the eligibility requirement that a nominee must declare all his/her private business holdings;
- Identification of provisions suitable for transfer into a Regulation; and
- Establishment of a body to review decisions of the Electoral Officer in an expeditious manner
