# Launch of Kahnawake911 central info hub for emergency service-related situations

### For Immediate Release

**(Kahnawake – 12, Enniskó:wa/March 2020)** The Public Safety Division of the Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke (MCK), Kahnawake Mohawk Peacekeepers and Kahnawà:ke Fire Brigade wish to announce the launch of **Kahnawake911**, a new central information hub for emergency service-related situations on Facebook.

“We are currently in the midst of the COVID-19 outbreak,” said Lloyd Phillips, the Commissioner of Public Safety. “The emergency service providers are working together to ensure that correct up-to-date information is made available to community members on this new **Kahnawake911** page. This includes preventive measures to help limit the spread of the virus, measures being taken by Kahnawà:ke organizations that serve the public, and general updates.”
