Indian Day School deadline approaching, in-person assistance available next week

For immediate release

(Kahnawake – 27, Onerahtókha/April 2022) The Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke (MCK) wishes to remind the community that the Indian Day School (IDS) Settlement Agreement deadline is fast approaching, with less than three (3) months remaining to enter claims.

The MCK's IDS Settlement Coordinator, Louise Mayo, is advising claimants that she will be at the Post office and Tewa building next Monday (May 2) and Wednesday, June 1, from 10am to 4pm on both days. She will be available to answer questions and/or offer assistance regarding settlement files.

The **Claims Deadline is July 13, 2022**, at 11:59pm Pacific Standard Time (PST). All claims must be received by the Administrator by the Claims Deadline. It is the Claimants' responsibility to ensure their claim meets the Claims Deadline.

In order to meet the Claims Deadline:

- Claims submitted by **email or fax** must be received by the Claims Administrator or have an electronic, system-generated date stamp of no later than July 13, 2022, at 11:59 pm PST
- Claims Submitted by **regular mail or courier** must be received by the Claims Administrator or postmarked by Canada Post or courier service provider by no later than July 13, 2022, at 11:59 pm PST. For clarity, the term "postmark" refers to an official mark stamped on a letter or package by either Canada Post or a courier service indicating the date and time that the correspondence was received by Canada Post/courier service. A postmark may not be automatically applied by the post office or courier service. Therefore, **it is the responsibility of the Claimant to request and obtain a postmark on their claim submission**
- For greater certainty, a Claim submission may be received by the Claims Administrator after **July 13, 2022, at 11:59 pm PST**, so long as the electronic, system-generated date stamp (in the case of email or fax) or postmark (in the case of regular mail or courier) indicated on the correspondence is **before** the Claims Deadline)

PLEASE NOTE: Claims submitted by regular mail or courier that are received by the Claims Administrator after the Deadline without a postmark will be deemed to have been received after the Deadline and may not be accepted. Click on the link for further info:
