## **Low-Cost Spay and Neuter Clinic dates announced for Summer**

**(Kahnawake – 12, Ohiarí:ha/June 2018)** The Animal Protection Department is now scheduling appointments for the next series of Low-Cost Spay and Neuter Clinics for cats and dogs.

All services are provided at a significantly reduced rate, but there is a maximum of five (5) dog and cat procedures each performed on the following dates:

- **Wednesday, July 4<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup>**
- **Wednesday, August 8<sup>th</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup>**
- **Wednesday, September 12<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup>**

Prices vary according to the weight and sex of the animal. Scheduling an appointment and a \$20 deposit is required - all fees are the responsibility of the pet owner.

Animals will be transported to Timberlea Veterinary Clinic in Kirkland at an additional cost of \$15 (\$20 for non-residents). Pet owners are asked to provide their cages and carriers.

Please note that a \$20 annual Kahnawà:ke Animal Protection Membership fee will apply for non-residents. This membership provides access to all clinics throughout the year.
