Call for Decision-makers on the Administrative Tribunal

(Kahnawake – 24, Ohiarihkó:wa/July 2024)

The Justice Services Division of the Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke is inviting interested persons to submit applications for a Professional Services Agreement to serve as Decision-makers on the Administrative Tribunal. The submission period begins today, Wednesday, July 24, 2024, and ends at 4pm on Friday, August 23, 2024. There are three (3) vacancies to fill.

Decision-makers will perform the duties set forth in the *Kahnawà:ke Justice Act* and related regulations and any other applicable Kahnawà:ke laws, regulations, policies, or procedures on an "as needed" basis. Decision-makers are responsible for reviewing decisions of the administrative branch of Kahnawà:ke government.

Applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- be at least 18 years old;
- not have been convicted of an indictable offence unless they meet one of the exceptions listed in article 3.3 of the <u>Regulation</u> <u>Respecting the Institution and Management of the</u> <u>Administrative Tribunal</u>;
- not have been convicted of a summary conviction offence within the last six (6) years;
- have formal legal training, which means having completed an undergraduate degree in law at a recognized North American University; and
- be in good standing with their professional order or have retired in good standing, if applicable.

The term of office is five (5) years.

Information on the terms of office, remuneration and responsibilities of Decision-makers can be found in the <u>Terms of Reference</u>.

Applications can be picked up and dropped off at the Court of Kahnawà:ke during regular business hours. Submissions must be accompanied by a letter of intent, a resume, the names and contact information of two (2) professional references, and proof of educational requirements.
