Leslie began her career at the Kahnawà:ke Legislative Coordinating Commission (KLCC), now known as the Kahnawà:ke Legislative Committee (KLC) in 2011. In July of 2014, Leslie became the Interim Coordinator for the KLCC, and in 2018 was appointed as the KLCC Coordinator. Additionally, Leslie is also the longest serving member of the Legislative Commission.

“Leslie has been invaluable to the success of the KLCC and the Community Decision Making Process. Her passion for her work was evidenced by her commitment to the founding principles of the commission and the legislative process. She also worked at Dawson College in Montreal, the Assembly of First Nations and for the Outreach Research Project, “Bridging the Gap.”
