Essential Snow Removal Program for Elderly and Disabled returns for 2014-2015

(Kahnawake – 1, Kenténha/October 2014) The Special Projects Division of the Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke (MCK) is pleased to announce that the Essential Snow Removal service for low income elderly and disabled community members will be in operation from December 1st, 2014 to March 31st, 2015.

The snow removal is intended for low-income community members without any ablebodied relatives to assist them. The service will provide access to residences for emergency services and includes clearing of the driveway and/or walkway and steps. The program is accepting a maximum of 65 clients; previous clientele will need to reapply for this service.

- A person 65 years of age or older or a person who is physically disabled.
 - The person/couple is someone who lives alone with limited income and has little or no extended family.
 - The person/couple is someone who has a medical problem (either short term or long term).
 - The person/couple is someone who has no family to look out for their well-being.
