

ANNOUNCEMENT


(Kahnawake - 15, Kentenhkó:wa/November 2024)

The Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke (MCK) has been informed by the Ministère des Transports du Québec that deck repair work on the Mercier Bridge will take place tonight, Friday, November 15th from **10pm until Saturday 11am**. One (1) lane will be available in each direction (counter-flow traffic configuration) on the Kahnawake bound side of the span. The Airlie entrance and exit will be open during this intervention. Additionally, The Jacques-Cartier and Champlain Bridges Inc will be conducting maintenance and electrical work on the access ramps and approaches. See schedule and detour maps below.

- R-132 West (from La Prairie/A-30 towards Montreal) CLOSED
 Friday & Saturday from 10pm until 5am
- R-132 East (from Montreal towards La Prairie/A-30) CLOSED
 Friday & Saturday from 10pm until 5am
- R-138 East (from Chateauguay towards Montreal) CLOSED Sunday from 10pm until Monday 5am



Please drive with caution, slow down when entering construction zones, and respect the Move-Over Law when emergency lights are flashing.
