## Partial lane closures on 132 in both directions Monday

**(Kahnawake – 17, Kentenhkó:wa/ November 2017)** The Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke has been informed by Jacques Cartier & Champlain Bridges Incorporated that work to remove overhead lights and traffic signals at the former detour road on Route 132 will be carried out on Monday, November 20<sup>th</sup> starting at 9:30 am.

As a result, the left lane of the 132 west (direction Montreal) and 132 east (direction La Prairie) will be closed in the area between the intersection of the 132/Old Malone (Depot Road) and the bottom of the access ramps (see picture below).



The work is expected to take several hours and may cause significant delays to motorists.

The MCK reminds the public that these works are subject to change due to weather conditions, operational constraints or work progression and that it does not take part in the scheduling or cancellation of such works.
