
Q4 Would you be willing to rent a communal cabin in Tioweró:ton in lieu of building a place of your own?

Q5 Please select the following areas you feel can be developed:Check all that apply










Q7 Which areas should be set aside for recreational Activities only?Check all that apply



Our guidelines need to evolve to ensure that these trees that are cut are not just wasted. There are a number of things that they could be used forinstead of piling on the side of the road to waste away. Those resources can be used to produce lumber for cabin construction or sold and used for the maintenance and up keep of the lands. This does not equate to making a profit from the resources but rather better managing what is being harvested and putting it back to continuously improve Tioweroton. We must think outside the box and evolve our thinking. Instead of just wasting. We need to find creative ways to manage and re-use what is being harvested. As far as the shooting range is concerned, it needs to be upgraded to be more safe for everyone to use. The range is a necessity to ensure that hunters are sighting in their rifles before hunting to increase the odds of a clean and successful hunt with the least amount of suffering to the animals. As for Cabin construction it should remain with in the boundaries that are in place however open as many viable areas within said boundaries to ensure optimal lots available. The northern end and lake areas should not be open to construction. As the land base is so small these areas need to be protect and kept solely for medicines, hunting and fishing purposes. Once these areas are inhabited this will cause negative effects on the animals, plants and will reduce the safe areas to hunt and fish.
