Safety and Health on the Job

Each year thousands of workers are injured or killed on the job. Kahnawake workers and their families are no strangers to on the job injuries, illnesses, or fatalities. On the job injuries cost employers, their employees, families and insurance providers hundreds of thousands of dollars per year.

The Kahnawake Occupational Safety and Health Office along with the Mohawk Self Insurance Program, are working continuously to reduce these costs and to reach a goal of Zero injuries on the job.

To achieve this goal, we need you, the employee to ensure that your employer has an adequate Safety Program which will assist you in protecting your own safety on the job.

The Kahnawake Occupational Safety and Health Office of the Community Protection Unit is available to help employers and employees on how to eliminate hazards on the job or in your workplace.

Employers are obligated to provide their employees with a workplace which is free of recognized hazards, but as employee's, we are ultimately responsible for own safety. Stay alert, report unsafe conditions to your supervisor immediately and always wear Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) when required.
