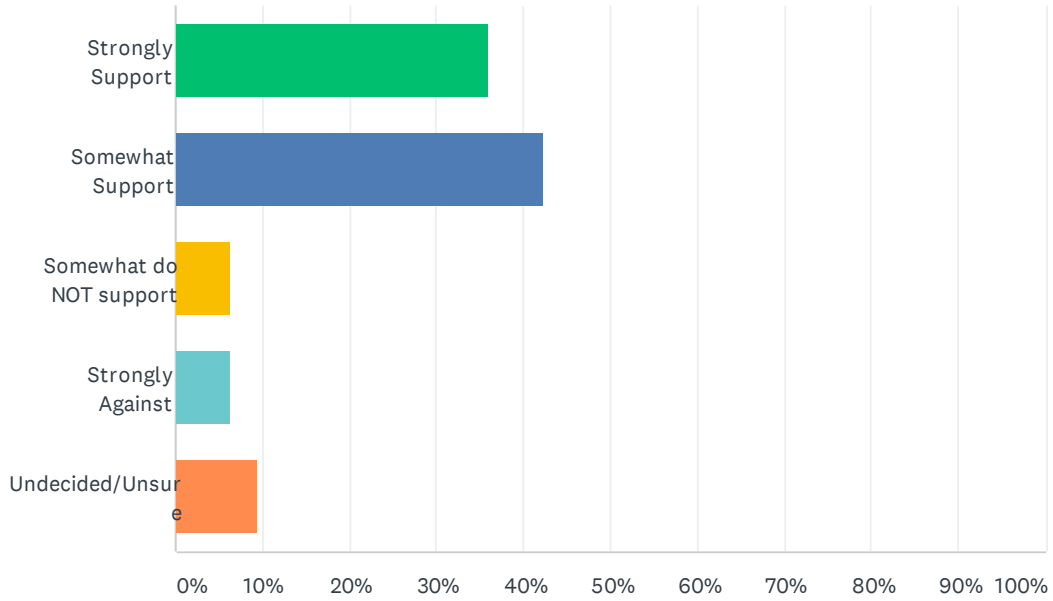


Q1 How strongly do you support the MCK investing \$1-4 million of a \$3.4-7 million Aquaponics food supply system on common land?

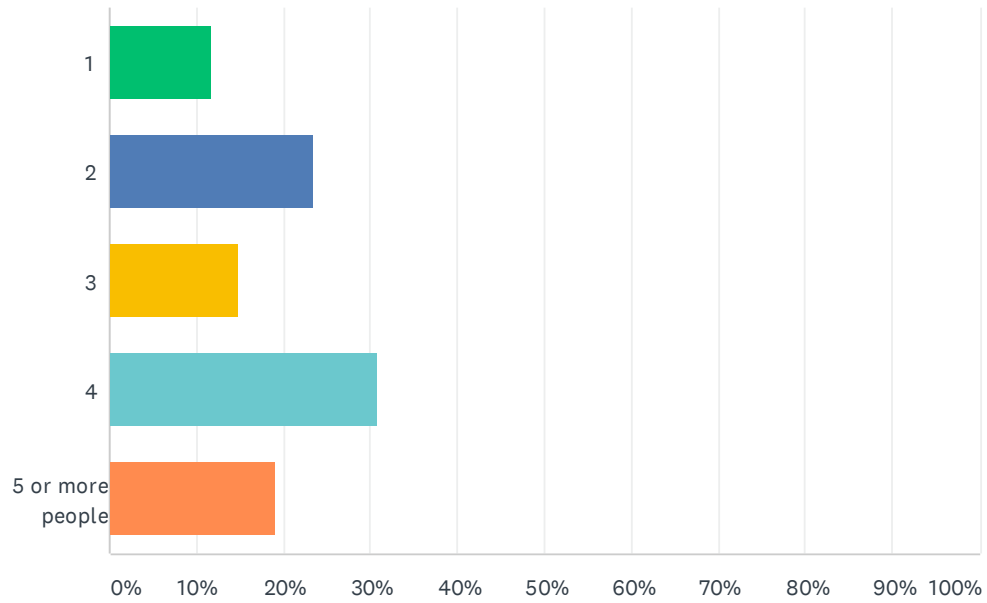

Q2 How many people do you currently buy, grow or hunt food for?

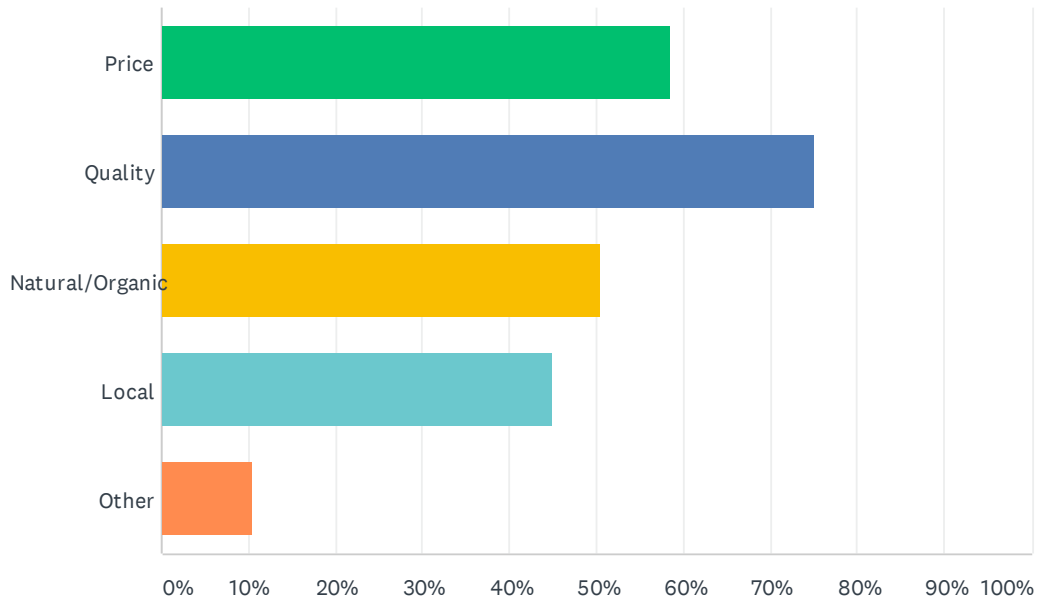

Q3 What is your main criteria when buying food? Click all that apply

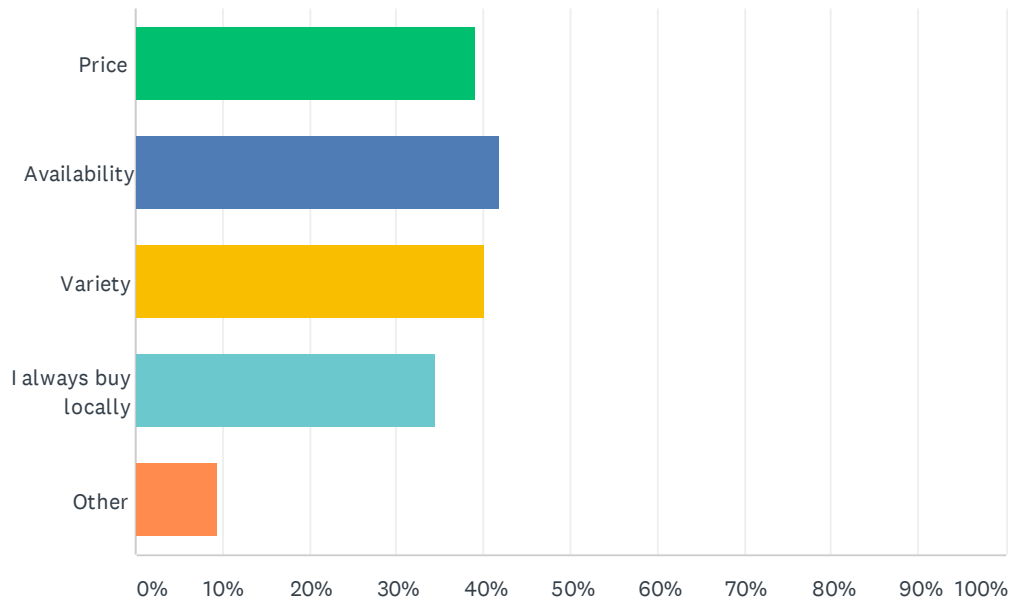

Q4 What is your main reason for NOT buying food locally? Click all that apply

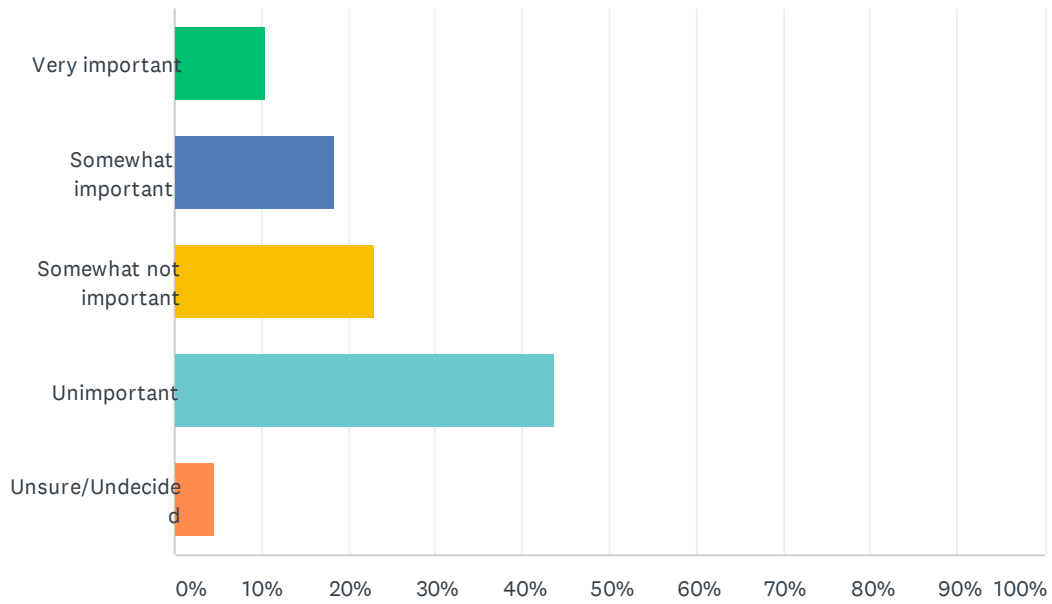

Q5 How important is having food & fish pre-cooked, smoked, seasoned and/or pre-cut when purchasing?

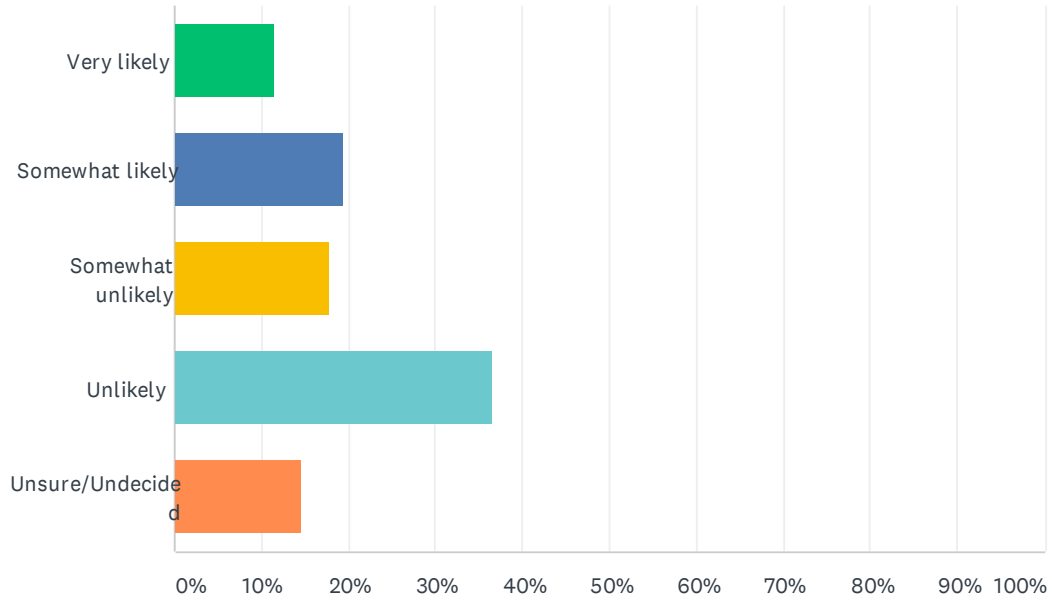

Q6 How likely are you to work in the Kahnawà:ke Food industry should jobs be made available in the harvesting of food?

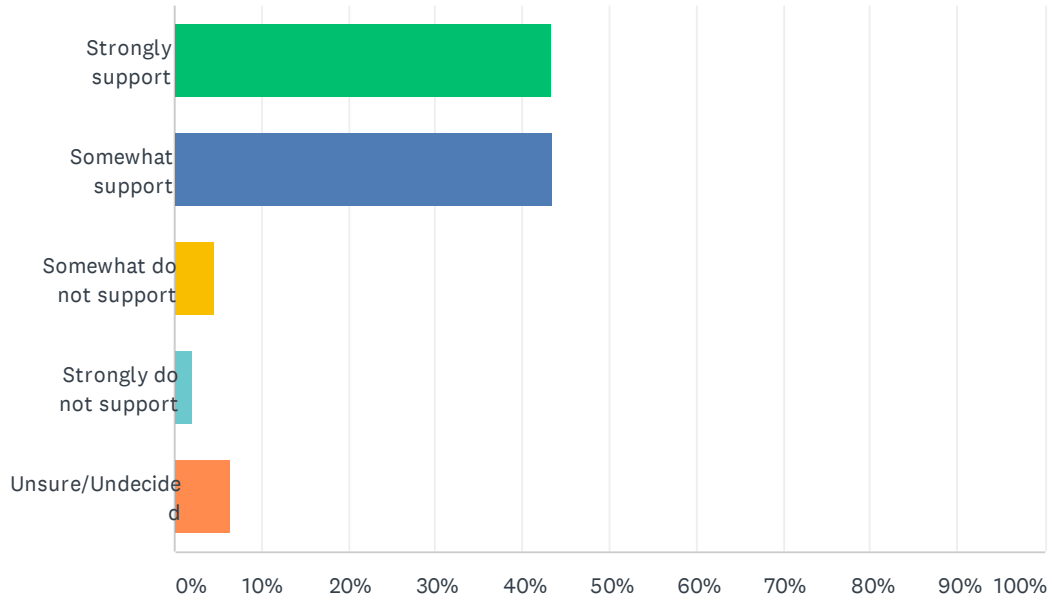

Q7 How much would you support selling food to non-locals to help sustain Kahnawà:ke's future food industry?

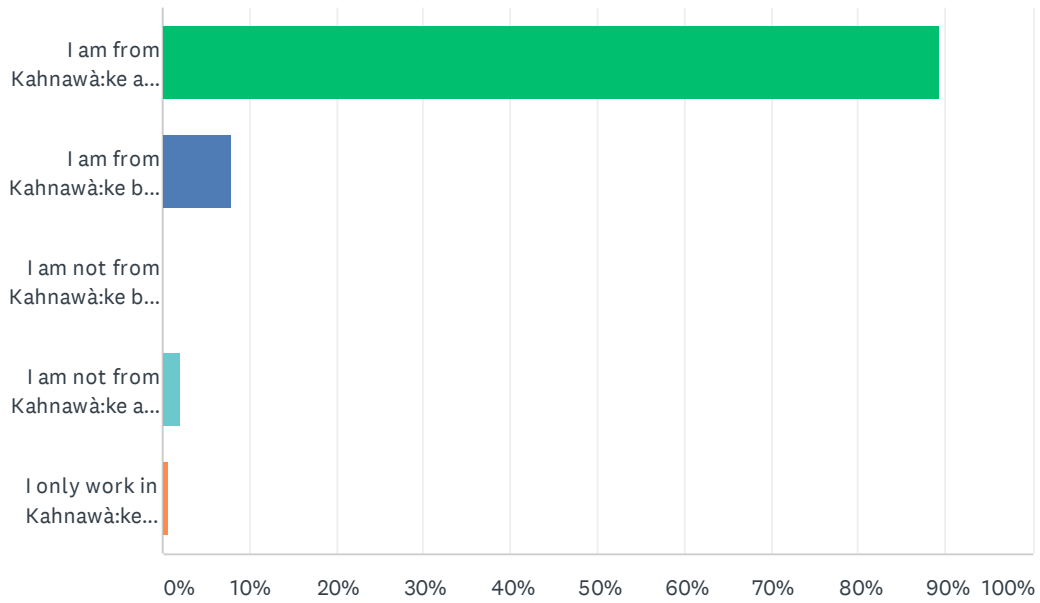

Q8 What is your affiliation to Kahnawà:ke?

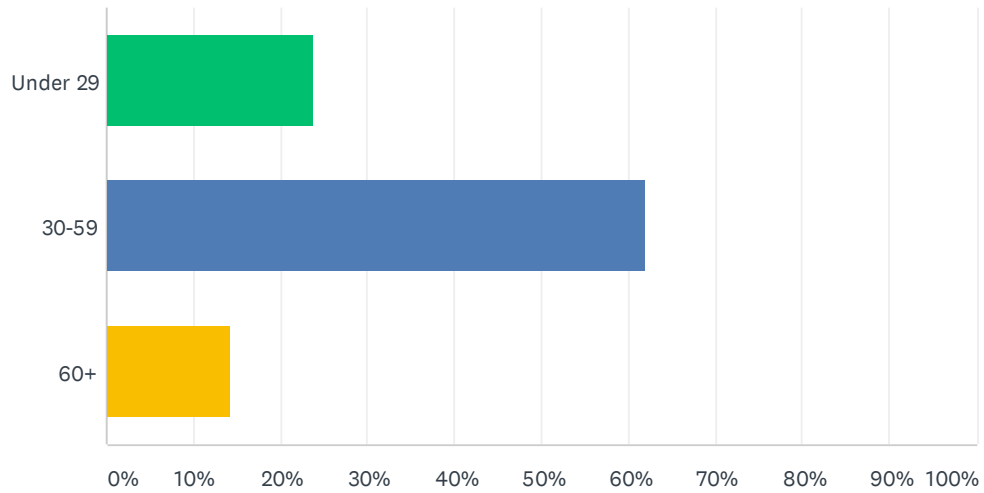
