

# Q1 How strongly do you support the MCK investing \$1-4 million of a \$3.4-7 million Aquaponics food supply system on common land?





### Q2 How many people do you currently buy, grow or hunt food for?





### Q3 What is your main criteria when buying food? Click all that apply





## Q4 What is your main reason for NOT buying food locally? Click all that apply





# Q5 How important is having food & fish pre-cooked, smoked, seasoned and/or pre-cut when purchasing?





## Q6 How likely are you to work in the Kahnawà:ke Food industry should jobs be made available in the harvesting of food?





# Q7 How much would you support selling food to non-locals to help sustain Kahnawà:ke's future food industry?




