

Q1 Are you aware that individuals not on the Kahnawà:ke Kanien'kehá:ka Registry (KKR) can possess land in Kahnawà:ke?





Q2 Should only people on the KKR be able to possess Kahnawà:ke land?







Q4 Should there be a limit to how much land one individual can possess ?











Q8 Which activities should be prohibited on common lands? Choose all that apply:





Q9 Would you support land allotments remaining common land in the same manner as the duplexes? (i.e. you own the structure, but the land remains common)




