**(Kahnawake – 19, Enniskó:wa/March 2021)** The Kahnawà:ke COVID-19 Task Force wishes to remind the community that there are still appointments available to receive the COVID-19 vaccination for tomorrow, Saturday, March 20<sup>th</sup>, and Tuesday, March 23<sup>rd</sup>.

Please ensure that you have your Medicare card in hand when booking an appointment.

Applicants should receive a confirmation by email that their appointment has been confirmed. If you apply by telephone and there is a voicemail, please leave a message, and someone will get back to you.
