**(Kahnawake – 28 Onerahtókha/April 2025)** The Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke (MCK) wishes to inform the community that Ratsénhaienhs Paul Rice will be traveling to Toronto, Ontario, for the 8th annual First Nations Major Projects Coalition Conference (FNMPCC) – Valuing Reconciliation in Global Markets. The conference will take place from 27 - 29 Onerahtókha/April 2025.

Rice will be speaking on the Financing Electricity Projects panel to leading Indigenous, corporate, government and industry representatives. As an investor in renewable energy, the MCK will present on how equity participation strengthens both the commercial success and sustainability of renewable energy projects. Onkwehón:we communities have always been strong economic partners which is even more important in the current business climate.
