

POLITICAL AGENDA

The Council of Chiefs of the MCK have set a political agenda for the 2018-2021 term, that sets a focus on protecting and asserting the rights and interests of the community and its members through the following 3 key priorities:

1 EXTERNAL GOVERNMENT RELATIONS

▶ Objective: Establish with external governments, Agreements that uphold the respecting of Kahnawà:ke governance and jurisdiction, and are based on political priorities & principles

2 MEMBERSHIP

- ▶ <u>Objective</u>: Establish and implement a community-driven position and strategy in opposition to Canada's attempts to assimilate Kanien'kehá:ka and First Nations via Bill S3 and Indian Act registration
- ► <u>Objective:</u> Support Nation work to address matters of Citizenship & Nation Relations

3 SOCIAL SUPPORTS

- ▶ <u>Objective:</u> Establish initiatives that support families / parents / elders through economic and social measures
- ► <u>Objective:</u> Support and engage in community development initiatives, such as the Kahnawà:ke Collective Impact Initiative

POLITICAL & STRATEGIC DIRECTION

In addition to the key priorities, the Council of Chiefs has established political and strategic direction for work in the following 6 MCK portfolios:

- **6** ► Justice
