Question of the role of the administrative tribunal in decisions of either of these bodies.

**Justice:** Justice Services Mandate and Justice Portfolio Team Mandate approved. Review of Communal Arbitration discussed - to be conducted.

**Cannabis file:** Discussions on Inspectors/Compliance Officers – regulation to be drafted. A legal review of the Kahnawa:ke Cannabis Control Law and the Regulations to be carried out to identify what amendments are required to transition the regulatory framework.
