Justice Portfolio: The Regulation Respecting Eligibility Criteria for the Appointment of Judges to the Court of Kahnawa:ke and the Regulation Respecting the Selection and appointment of Judges to the Court of Kahnawa:ke were both enacted. The remuneration for Judges of the Court of Kahnawa:ke was presented to the Council for formal approval. Two decision-makers were formally sworn in by me to the Administrative Tribunal. The two decision-makers attended an all day orientation provided by Justice Services. Implementation of the Administrative Tribunal is complete with the exception of one remaining regulation to draft and enact: the Regulation Respecting Disciplinary Measures for Decision-Makers. The Kahnawa:ke Justice Commission Constitution is undergoing final review. Suggested amendments (sections on oversight, responsibilities, composition) will be approved by the Justice Commission before final approval of the amended Constitution by MCED. A Sectoral Table on Justice is being established with the Federal Government through the Kahnawa:ke Canada Relations (KCR) table. The mandate for that sectoral table is currently being drafted.

Governance Portfolio: The Media Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) was finalized and reviewed by the Council of Chiefs and local media representatives. Local media met with the Council to discuss the draft MOU. A summary of that meeting and the issues raised by the local media reps was provided at the community meeting. Those present at the community meeting were asked to fill out a questionnaire with the following two (2) questions? Should non-KKR local media journalists be permitted in community meetings? Should local media present at a community meeting be permitted to record the meeting for accuracy in their reporting? Responses obtained will be discussed at our next internal meeting on this matter. The Governance Advisory Team has completed a first full review of the Code of Conduct for the Council of Chiefs and will perform one final review before posting the revised version and going out to the community for feedback/input.

Cannabis File: Developmental work continues. Numerous discussions amongst the Council have been taking place regarding the opposition to the implementation of a regulated legal cannabis industry. Discussions continue.
