## **Route 132 one lane in each direction tonight**

**(Kahnawake – 25 Ohiarí:ha/June 2025)**

The Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke (MCK) would like to advise the community that work on the overhead signs on Route 132 will continue tonight, Wednesday, June 25<sup>th</sup>, from **9:30pm until 5am**. Set up for the lane closure and detour will begin at **8:30pm**.

The partial lane closure is required for site preparation, overhead sign dismantlement and excavation of the foundations at two (2) locations between the ramps of the Mercier Bridge and the lights at the Old Malone Highway intersection.

A counter-flow traffic detour will be in place in the East-bound lanes of R-132, and motorists will be able to access the R-132 West up ramp (from La Prairie towards Montreal).

Please drive with caution, slow down when entering construction zones, and respect the Move-Over Law when emergency lights are flashing.

The MCK reminds the public that these works are subject to change due to weather conditions, operational constraints, or work progression.
