The Client Based Services Unit of the Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke is pleased to introduce Tricia Collier, F.PL., the new Indigenous Tax and Estate Planning Advisor. Tricia is a Personal Financial Planner who brings a wealth of knowledge and experience to support Kahnawà'kehró:non in navigating complex estate and taxation matters. Her role is dedicated to helping community members make informed decisions, understand their rights, and access the services they need.

Tricia is available to answer questions about taxation, including issues with the Point of Sale Agreement with Quebec, tax charges on deliveries to the Reserve, and income tax matters. Additionally, she provides guidance to businesses on how to properly apply tax exemptions for Kahnawà:ke clients under the Kahnawà:ke/Quebec agreement.

On the Estate Planning front, Tricia offers guidance on preparing Wills and navigating the Indigenous Services Canada system. This includes support for validating Wills, applying to be an executor or administrator, and addressing issues related to executorship and administration. She also provides advice on Power of Attorney and Protection Mandates to ensure community members are well-prepared for the future.
