June 2025

Infrastructure, Transportation & Operations (ITO) Portfolio: We had two bi-weekly meetings with Jacques Cartier Champlain Bridge Incorporated (JCCBI). Discussions regarding ongoing bridge and pier works. Discussed the abutment stabilization project, the 70-year-old abutments will be upgraded to current seismic standards. Erosion of the abutment materials is apparent due to climate change. Discussed reopening of the cross over road along Kanawaki golf club. Hydro Quebec, we had met to discuss the Part 2 of vegetation management that will start in September. The ITO portfolio met to discuss the current Transportation User Fees (TUF). Preliminary meeting with MTMD (MTQ) to discuss the Quebec portion Mercier Bridge Design. Meeting with Ministere des Transport (MTQ) and First Nations Inuit Relations Secretariat to discuss the Mercier Bridge Project.

Health Portfolio: Attended monthly meetings at Onkwata'karitáhtshera Table, Board of Directors at Kahnawake Shakotiia'takehnhas Community Services (KSCS) and the Board of Directors and the Kateri Memorial Hospital Centre (KMHC). Had a meeting with KSCS regarding the Community Wellness Plan. Had a follow up meeting with GSK Pharmaceuticals, they gave a presentation on the health situations across Turtlte Island and the awareness of increase of diseases.

External Government Relations Portfolio: I attended the monthly External Government Relations Portfolio Meeting. Raised awareness of *Ouebec's Bill 106*.

Justice: Consequential amendments to various laws were enacted (necessary for the implementation of the *Kahnawake Justice Act*). Community Justice Center project planning and preparation continue regarding funding of the building and land designation.

Governance: Legal Services (LS) completed the review of the Draft *Code of Conduct for the Ratitsénhaienhs*Governance Advisory Team (GAT) to discuss LS comments and schedule dates for special kiosks. The GAT began the revision of the "Terms of Reference for the Ratsénhaienhs/letsénhaienhs"

Cannabis file: Discussions continued from previous month regarding opposition and concerns with a regulated cannabis industry. Developmental work was stalled as a moratorium on the sale of retail cannabis was issued and members of the Cannabis Control Board did not seek re-appointment or resigned.
