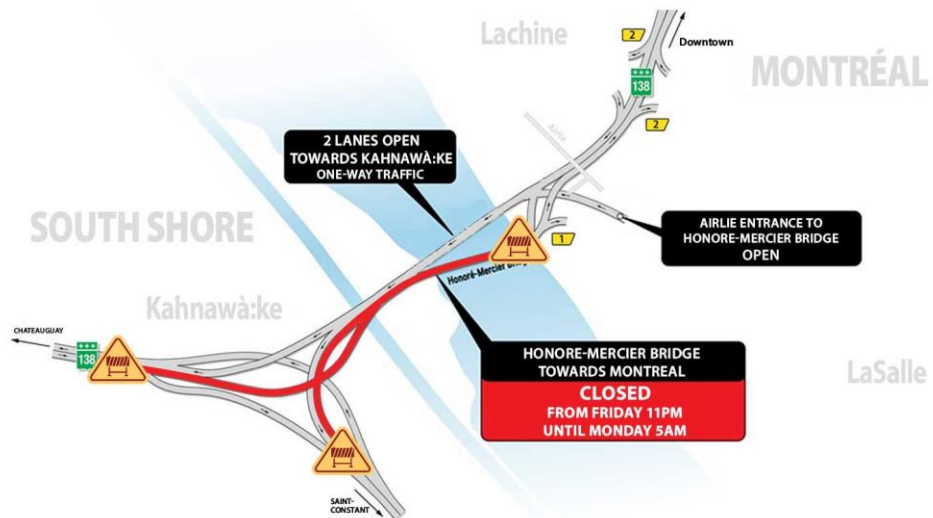

## Montreal bound Mercier Bridge closed this weekend

(Kahnawake – 18 Seskehkó:wa/September 2025)

The Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke (MCK) has been informed by the Jacques Cartier & Champlain Bridges Incorporated that paving work will require the complete closure of the Montreal bound Mercier Bridge this weekend.

The closure will be in place from **Friday, September 19<sup>th</sup> at 11pm until Monday, September 22<sup>nd</sup> at 5am.**



The Kahnawà:ke bound span will have both lanes open and the R-138 West down ramp (towards Chateauguay) and the R-132 East down ramp (towards A-30/La Prairie) will be open.

Motorists heading to Montreal this weekend are being advised to avoid R-207 south, R-138 east and R-132 west through Kahnawà:ke and to follow the detour signs, A-30/R-132 to the Champlain Bridge.

Please drive with caution, slow down when entering construction zones, and respect the Move-Over Law when emergency lights are flashing.

The MCK reminds the public that these works are subject to change due to weather conditions, operational constraints, or work progression.
