Soil removal work scheduled at snow dump area on Route 132

(Kahnawake – 18 Onerahtohkó:wa/May 2026)

The Capital Unit of the Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke (MCK) wishes to inform the community of an upcoming project involving the removal of excavation soils located at the snow dump area adjacent to Route 132, which will be transported to an approved location off-territory.

Soil removal work is scheduled to begin on **Tuesday, May 19th**, and is expected to last approximately **7–10 days**. A map of the general area is provided below for reference. The outlined area indicates where the work will take place.



The MCK appreciates the community's patience and understanding during this temporary disruption and apologizes for any inconvenience it may cause.

Please note that all scheduled work is subject to change based on weather conditions, operational constraints, or project progression.
