KEPO releases draft Kahnawà:ke Environmental Vision for community consultation

(Kahnawake – 18 Ohiari:ha/June 2026)

The Kahnawà:ke Environment Protection Office (KEPO) wishes to inform the community that the first draft of the Kahnawà:ke Environmental Vision has been completed, marking the next phase of the project.

The draft vision is based on survey responses, engagements, and community events conducted over the past year. It is intended to guide future initiatives and serve as a shared goal for community-led environmental efforts.
