PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT

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Call for Decision-maker on the Administrative Tribunal

(Kahnawake – 15 Ohiarikhó:wa/July 2026)

The Justice Services Division of the Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke is inviting interested persons to submit applications for appointment as a Decision-maker on the Administrative Tribunal. The submission period begins Wednesday, July 15, 2026, and ends at 4pm on Friday, August 14, 2026. There is one (1) vacancy to fill.

Decision-makers will perform the duties set forth in the *Kahnawà:ke Justice Act* and related regulations, as well as any other applicable Kahnawà:ke laws, regulations, policies, or procedures, on an “as needed” basis. Decision-makers are responsible for reviewing decisions of the administrative branch of Kahnawà:ke government.

Applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- be at least 18 years old;
- not have been convicted of an indictable offence unless they meet one of the exceptions listed in article 3.3 of the [Regulation Respecting the Institution and Management of the Administrative Tribunal](#);
- not have been convicted of a summary conviction offence within the last six (6) years;
- have formal legal training, which means having completed an undergraduate degree in law at a recognized North American University; and
- be in good standing with their professional order or have retired in good standing, if applicable.

The term of office is five (5) years.

Applications must be accompanied by a letter of intent, a resume, the names and contact information of two (2) professional references, and proof of educational requirements.
